

## POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Your poster should be:

1. Presented in portrait layout and printed on **A1 POTRAIT (23" by 33")** size paper
  2. Be concise and well organized
  3. Simple with a clear "take home" message
  4. Attractive and aesthetically pleasing
  5. Be easy to read from a distance of at least 1 - 2 metres
  6. A mixture of graphics and text

The poster must include but not limited to:

1. A title
  2. Names of authors or contributors
  3. Address of authors or contributors
  4. A brief introduction.
  5. The method used
  6. Results
  7. Discussion/Conclusions
  8. References
  9. Acknowledgements

- Posters will remain on display for the whole duration of the conference. Remove your poster immediately at the close of the conference.
- On your designated board you will find all the materials needed for mounting your poster (poster number and Velcro).
- Poster ID will be given to each presenter a week before the conference. Please paste your poster (according to the ID given) in the first day of the conference.
- There will be poster judging session and three best poster awards will be given during the closing ceremony.
